Length of Commitment: 1-2 hours/week, Ongoing Position

Duties: The Film Series Coordinator will

- Brainstorm environmental films that would interest the larger community
- Submit film list and snack wish list to Education Program Manager for purchase
- Find venues for activities
- Plan dates and times
- Publicize the Film Series and recruit participants
- Assist in program evaluation
- Attend occasional meetings with other volunteers to help steer and shape the greater G.A.L.A. Community.

The Film Series Leaders may open the film with a brief introduction and announcements or may find another volunteer to do so. The Education Program Manager has many resources and is available to help.

Desired Qualifications: Volunteers do not need to have specific skills, but should have an interest in learning more about sustainability and other environmental issues. Volunteers must also have the time commitment needed to organize the Film Series.

What is meaningful about this position? The Film Series are a great way to expand your awareness by delving deeply into environmental issues. They also connect you to your greater community.

Training provided: Training will include a brief history of G.A.L.A., an overview of G.A.L.A.'s organization, an introduction to the volunteer meetings, and an open dialogue on strategies for program design and implementation. Training will also include more information on your specific job tasks.
