Duties: The Sustain-A-Raisers Coordinators will

- Supervise the activities of youth aged 12-18 completing sustainability home & yard improvement projects in the community
- Share knowledge with youth about sustainability
- Help market program, conduct outreach, and recruit volunteers.
- Serve as the community contact for Sustain-A-Raiser services
- Help maintain a schedule of Sustain-A-Raiser service projects
- Engage youth in program management
- Collect feedback surveys at the end of semester
- Attend occasional meetings with other volunteers to help steer and shape the greater G.A.L.A. Community.

The Sustain-A-Raisers Coordinators get a fun, hands-on experience working outdoors and inspiring youth action. The Community Enrichment Manager has many resources and is available to assist with activities.

Desired Qualifications: Volunteers should have light carpentry skills, an interest in working with young people, and a desire to learn more about easy and sustainable home and yard makeovers. Volunteers must also have the time commitment needed to help organize the Sustain-A-Raisers program.
